

Campers Cleaning Requirements

1. Collect and bag all trash. Reline all trash cans with appropriate sized bags. Leave all collected bags of trash inside the front door.
2. ***Chaparral, Magnolia, Aspen, Cactus, Pine, Yucca, and Slab Cabins ONLY:*** Replace all twin bed sheets in dorms with clean white sheets. (These will be delivered by camp staff to each cabin.) Leave dirty sheets in green/purple sheet tubs.
3. ***Elliott Lodge, Poison Ivy and Wilson Cabin ONLY:*** Wash and put away dishes in kitchen area.
4. Place all recreation equipment back where it was retrieved from.
5. Collect any trash that has been left outside on walkways, pathways, etc...
6. Return any borrowed items such as buckets, water jugs, staplers, keys, extension cords to the person you borrowed them from. Return all furniture and chairs to its original arrangement in every building used.
7. Honestly advise a staff member of any items that have been broken during your event that need replacing or repair.
9. Vacuum all carpeted floors.
10. Sweep all hard floors.
11. Mop all hard floors.
12. Clean all bathrooms: wash sinks and showers with antibacterial soap, wash toilets with antibacterial soap, scrub inside toilet bowls with bathroom cleaner. Wash mirrors, sweep and mop floors.
13. Sweep off porches.
14. Check to make sure all campers' items have been removed – don't forget under beds and window sills.

●Please note separate cleaning instructions for the dining hall which are posted on the corkboard. We appreciate the help of every group in this area.
